



Dress Code Policy and Update

As of 05.01.2023

Proper attire is required at all times while utilizing the facilities. Each resident/golf member is expected to dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the setting and appropriate for the occasion. It is expected that residents/golf members advise their guests to do the same. Men and women are required to wear appropriate "resort casual" attire.

Please note that during the February 20, 2023, Board Meeting it was determined that "resort casual" attire includes dress jeans as follows: *Acceptable dress jeans of any color are permitted in the dining facilities ONLY but must not be torn or faded.*

IN THE MAIN DINING ROOM

Men are required to wear shirts with sleeves. Pool attire, bare feet, and t-shirts are not allowed. Slacks or shorts with a minimum outside finished seam of 18 inches are considered to be proper attire. The wearing of baseball caps or visors will not be allowed in the Main Dining Room unless part of a golf outing. The attire for children under the age of 13 may be informal at the Dining Room Manager's discretion.

IN THE LOUNGE

Apparel should be appropriate to the surroundings and atmosphere of the casual lounge in a resort setting. Baseball caps, hats, and visors are acceptable in the Lounge. T-shirts are acceptable in the Lounge as long as no offensive language or printing is on them. Muscle shirts, tank tops, halter tops, cut-offs, and short shorts are not permissible. Due to health reasons, bare feet are not allowed.

POOLSIDE WHEN ORDERING FROM THE LOUNGE

Bathing suits must be covered prior to entering the restaurant to order. Due to health reasons, bare feet are not allowed.

Management shall have the final responsibility and authority for determining what attire may be deemed inappropriate. Failure to comply with the policies above may cause the person to be asked to change attire or result in refusal of admission or service.
