TREASURY REPORT

It was unanimous that we explore improvements to the current sound system in the ballroom. This would benefit the Concert Series, as well as the annual play production.

Country Dance Recap:

The entire committee agreed that the Country Dance was a huge success. People shared that they continue to be approached by members of the community who had a wonderful time.

Suggestions were made that when a committee member stands up to make announcement, they use the Herons Glen system to do so. The band sound systems are not usually set up for an individual person's announcement, and they announcements can be garbled. Martie Shea indicated that the HGRD staff has access to microphones, but she will show committee members how to use our own sound system for announcements.

It was further suggested that we have two tables for singles, as the one table we reserved for our next dance is full, and we could have designated a second table.

Pat Cryster suggested that we return to a double-check in system of numbers on the tickets and sheets to be provided of where people are sitting. There was some

confusion about seat assignments, minimal, but avoidable by using our previous check-in system.
