USGA Rules of Golf Govern All Play, Except Where Local Rules Apply

- Drop Areas provided on holes 4, 7, 11, 13, & 14 for shots played from the teeing ground.
- Sand/gravel area on holes 3, 8, 11, 16, & 18 are considered waste areas and you may ground your club. Sand/gravel areas on holes 9 & 10 are considered cart path.
- Free relief from the following conditions: Ornamental flower beds, landscaped areas that are in bounds, vehicle ruts & staked trees. One club length from nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole.
- Play is prohibited by Law from areas marked as Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESA). These areas are marked with a Green Topped Red Stake. Relief is a one stroke penalty, two club-lengths from point of entry, no closer to the hole.

Out of Bounds

- Marked by white poles/stakes with a black top.
- Left of the water's edge on holes 1, 2, 4, 11, 13, 16, 17, & 18 is considered Out of Bounds.
- Right of the water's edge on holes 2, 3, 6, 7, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, & 17 is considered Out of Bounds.
- Concrete edge of the roadway to the left of Hole 10 &12 and behind Hole 1 is considered Out of Bounds.

Golf Carts - Pace of Play - Course Etiquette

- All carts must stay 30 feet from the green. All golf course signs must be followed.
- Golf carts must remain on the cart path on all Par 3s, and near all greens and tees.
- Golf carts are to use the 90 degree rule on fairways unless notified of other specific course conditions. Golf carts should not be driven into or near landscaped areas or beyond any Out of Bounds markers.
- Pace of Play Please keep up with the group in front of you or allow faster players
 to play through during play. If you fall behind, a golf course Ranger will ask you to
 get back into position to help us keep an acceptable pace of play for all golfers.
- Please make sure to replace all divots with sand and repair ball marks on the greens.
