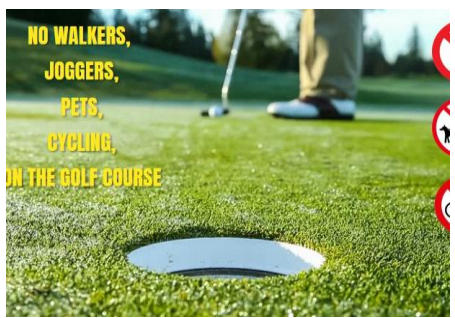
Golf Cart Registration
